



Declaration of Compliance

EUROPEAN REGULATION No. 1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)

The above listed product or product family is considered “articles” by the definitions provided in Article 3 (3) of the REACH regulation and do not contain substances “intended to release” under normal circumstances and as such, the registration requirements of Article 7(1) do not apply. However, Nutanix is aware of its obligations under Article 33(1) of REACH Regulation that requires manufacturers to promptly inform their customers within 45 days, if their products contain more than 0.1% by weight of the article of any Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) that are listed in ECHA’s Candidate List.

The candidate list as defined in Article 57 and Annex XIV of REACH Regulation was first published by the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) on 28th October, 2008. ECHA regularly revises the candidate list, and the latest is available at <http://echa.europa.eu/web/guest/candidate-list-table>

Based on the information provided by Nutanix’s suppliers, to the best of our knowledge, the Nutanix product or product family listed above does not contain any of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) listed in the “Candidate List: 168” as last amended on 17th December 2015 in a concentration above 0.1% weight of the product (article).

Nutanix monitors the candidate list on an ongoing basis for updates and will respond to Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) that are relevant to its product portfolio. Nutanix strives to avoid SVHC in its product portfolio for the benefit of its customers and the environment. Nutanix is actively evaluating its supply chain to identify safe and effective substitutes and will provide updated information to customers of any changes required for continued safe use of products or when amendments occur to the candidate list.
