Tip #1

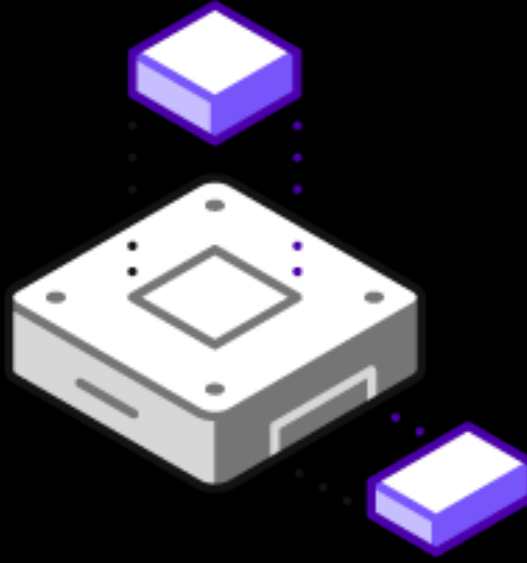
Know Your True Exposure
