

The Situation

Laxmi Laghubitta Bittiya Sanstha Limited (LxLB) is a microfinance subsidiary of Laxmi Bank, whose goal is to improve the quality of life for Nepal's economically disadvantaged people through inclusive and sustainable microfinance services. Since 2012, LxLB has opened 73 branches across 52 of Nepal's 77 districts to better serve its customers, and they wanted to take that even further by digitizing their services. One thing stood in their way: their traditional network infrastructure.

The Problem
